Proprietary food defining 'enablers'

- PFA 1955 37-A (2)(3) 1984: "a food which has
 - \diamond not been standardized under the PFA rules \Re
 - ♦ <u>name of that food or category</u> ₩... on the label
- ♦ FSSR -2011 (2.12):
 - ♦ not been standardized under these regulations"... shall also..
 - name describing as clearly <u>and/or category</u> \Re ;
 - the proprietary food product \mathbb{H} shall comply with.....

Proprietary food defining 'controllers'

- ♦ FSSA 2006: …
 - > an article of food \mathbb{H} ... standards not been specified
 - but is not unsafe" #
- ♦ FSSR 2016 [2.12.1(1)]:
 - > an article of food \mathbb{H} not been standardized \mathbb{H} ,
 - ➢ but does not include ₩ Novel foods, FSDU FSMP , HS & N
 - > and such other food articles which the CG may notify in this behalf


