

PREVENTION OF FOOD ADULTERATION (...AMENDMENT) RULES, 2006

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 17th/21st July, 2006

***G.S.R. 440(E).**- The following draft of certain rules further to amend the Prevention of Food Adulteration Rules, 1955, which the Central Government, after consultation with the Central Committee for Food Standards, proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) read with sub-section (1A) of section 23 of the Prevention of Food Adulteration Act, 1954 (37 of 1954), is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) of section 23 of the said Act, for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, and notice is hereby given that the said draft rules will be taken into consideration after the expiry of a period of sixty days from the date on which the copies of the Gazette of India in which this notification is published, are made available to the public.

The objections and suggestions, which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft rules within the period specified above, will be considered by the Central Government.

DRAFT RULES

- (1) These rules may be called the **Prevention of Food Adulteration (...Amendment) Rules, 2006**.
- (2) They shall come into force after six months from the date of their final publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Prevention of Food Adulteration Rules, 1955, in sub-rule (2) of rule 65, in the Table, after serial number 121, and the entries relating thereto, the following serial numbers and entries shall be inserted, namely, -
