

EDIBLE OILS PACKAGING (REGULATION) AMENDMENT ORDER, 2005

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 22nd November, 2005

***G.S.R. 684(E).**— In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955), the Central Government hereby makes the following Order further to amend the Edible Oils Packaging (Regulation) Order, 1998, namely:-

1. (1) This Order may be called the **Edible Oils Packaging (Regulation) Amendment Order, 2005.**

(2) It shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Edible Oils Packaging (Regulation) Order, 1998,-

(a) in clause 2, for sub-clause (c), the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“(c) “Edible Oils Commissioner” means the Edible Oils Commissioner appointed by the Central Government under clause 3A and includes any other person empowered by the Central Government to exercise any or all of the functions of the Edible Oils Commissioner under this Order.”

3. After clause 3, the following clause shall be inserted, namely:-

“3A. Appointment of Edible Oils Commissioner.— (1) The Central Government shall appoint an officer to be an Edible Oils Commissioner to exercise any or all the functions of Edible Oils Commissioner under this Order.

(2) The Central Government may also empower any other officer to exercise any or all the functions of the Edible Oils Commissioner under this Order:

Provided that such officer shall not be an officer below the rank of Development Officer in the Directorate of Vanaspati, Vegetables Oils and Fats.

(3) The Edible Oils Commissioner or any other officer to exercise the functions of an Edible Oils Commissioner shall possess Master’s degree in Chemistry preferably in Organic Chemistry or Post-Graduate Degree in Oils Technology from a recognized University or equivalent and should have 12 years’ experience (including executive / administrative experience) in an organization connected with Edible Oils, Vanaspati and Fats.”
