In the notification of Government of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (Department of Health) No. G.S.R. 185(E), dated the 21st March, 2005 [Prevention of Food Adulteration (IInd Amendment) Rules, 2005] Published in Part II, Section 3, Sub-section (i) at Page 1-106 of the Gazette of India, Extraordinary and read with corrigendum No. G.S.R. 596(E), dated the 20th September, 2005, G.S.R. 159(E), dated the 16th March, 2006, G.S.R. 575(E), dated the 19th September, 2006, G.S.R. 606(E), dated the 19th September, 2007 and G.S.R. 657(E), dated the 18th September, 2008 published in Part II, Section 3, Sub-section (i) of the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, at page 57, subrule (2) of rule 1, shall read as follows:-

“(2) They shall come into force after six months from the date of publication in the Official Gazette except item Nos. A-16.6, A-16.9, A-16.10, A-16.15, A-16.30 and A-16.41 of rule 2(ii) which shall come into force on 20th June, 2009.”
